



Services on offer

One to one sessions using programmes such as 'Talking to My Mum' suitable for 5-8 year olds. 'Talking about Domestic Abuse' suitable for 8 years plus.

Group work using 'Feeling Safe'.

Sessions offered will be up to 10 and may use other resources and interventions as suitable.

We will also offer advice and signposts to other services as well as Peterborough Women's Aid adult support for parents/carers.
